Prayer Vigil: Each Tuesday through the month of February St. Paul's members are invited to take 15 minutes from 4:00 – 4:15 PM to pray for our country, community and church wherever you are. The church sanctuary will be open during that time, too.

Community Meals for January & February have been canceled due to COVID and the uncertain winter weather. We plan to resume the meals in March.

Maintenance Projects: Good News, the roof repair is finished, the organ is now at full strength and the new computers have been installed. Next, we tackle the Sunday school tower's stained glass window that is allowing water intrusion and fix the water-damaged sanctuary ceiling. The total cost for these projects is well over \$150,000.00. So far, we have received \$41,969.47! Thank you. With the Lord's help and your generosity, we will complete these projects and keep our facilities presentable to all who worship with us and, most importantly, to God. You may give to this fund online at our church website or use the envelopes labeled "Upcoming Maintenance Projects" available at the rear of the sanctuary. Envelopes may be placed in the offering plate or mailed to the church.

The Bible Adventure Released Time Bible Program is now using our facilities. It is run by Joy-El Ministries, a Christian organization committed to "providing an opportunity for public school students to receive Biblical instruction from caring adults." Approximately 15 students in grades 3-5 from Pleasant View Elementary participate in the program on Wednesdays from 1:30 – 3:30 PM. All we do is open our facility. Transportation and teaching staff are provided by Joy-El and The Red Lion Bible Church. We are excited to support this ministry.
