The Den is an afterschool program that provides homework help and character development lessons to the students at Mazie Gable Elementary School.

For the past 7 years, we have been able to build strong relationships with many families who are in need. Because of these relationships, the local churches in the Red Lion area have been able to provide a lot of support to these families. The National Honor Society of the Red Lion Senior High School has adopted The Den to be their yearly service project. These students have enabled us to provide a mentoring program similar to that of the Big Brothers and Big Sisters program.

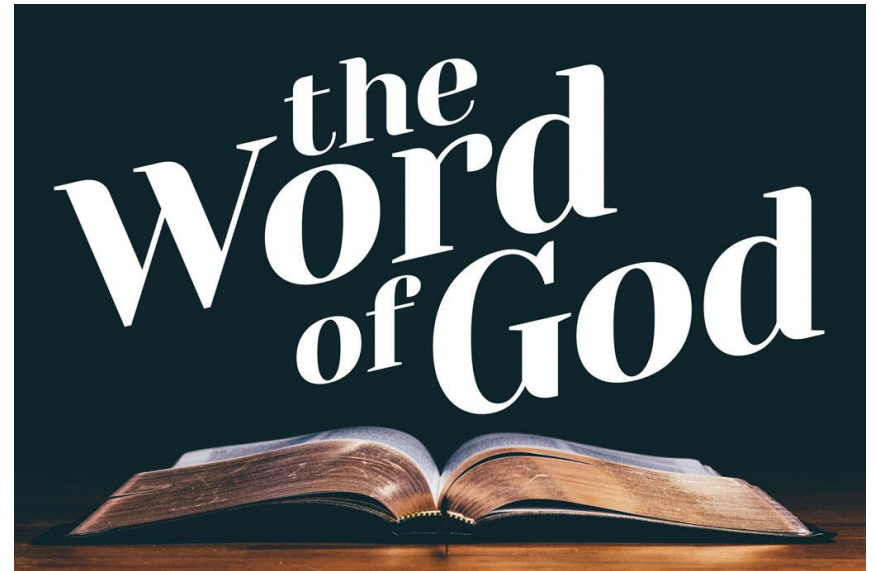
